Since its earliest days as a Quaker coach stop and schoolhouse, The Milton Inn has evolved into a beloved fine-dining destination where generations of Baltimoreans have marked life's most meaningful occasions. Now part of the award-winning Tony Foreman + Co. family and led by Chef and Co-Owner Chris Scanga, The Milton Inn begins a new chapter grounded in French culinary tradition and Mid-Atlantic

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seasonality.

Chef Scanga's ingredient-driven menus celebrate the region's bounty, highlighting produce, meat, and seafood from over two dozen local farms and purveyors. A commitment to sustainability informs every element of the experience—from sourcing and production to service and hospitality. Whether in our intimate private rooms or across the entire estate, The Milton Inn offers a setting where timeless charm and culinary excellence come together to create lasting memories.

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With a variety of distinct spaces—ranging from cozy and intimate to grand and expansive—The Milton Inn is perfectly suited for celebrations of all kinds. THE MAIN DINING ROOM

Our Main Dining Room glows with timeless touches of velvet, leather, and wood from the original historic building. A fabulous French parquet wood floor covers the entire room. Seats up to 32. Located on the 1st floor.

THE PARLOR

Our most private space begins with a baseline of an original 1840s white pine floor that was discovered during its creation. A beautiful collection of white ceramics, warm brass accents, and beautiful original artwork create a notable peace to the space. Seats up to 24.

THE STABLE

The most intimate, and quite frankly, the most relaxed of the spaces, The Stable is ideal for intimate, casual gatherings. Featuring a plush tufted leather banquette, deep green walls, and original oil paintings make for an incredibly handsome room. Seats up to 14. Located on the 1st floor.



THE PATIO

A SETTING REMINISCENT OF THE FRENCH COUNTRYSIDE, OUR GORGEOUS, STATE- OF-THE-ART PATIO IS SURROUNDED BY MILTON INN'S BEAUTIFUL GARDENS AND FEATURES AN OUTDOOR STONE FIREPLACE AND FULL OUTDOOR HEAT CONTROL. SEATS UP TO 40.

THE BAR & LOUNGE

The combined Bar & Lounge space at The Milton Inn can be a supporting cocktail reception space when rented in addition to other rooms on the property. The Bar & Lounge are located adjacent to The Stable, The Hearth, The Main Dining Room and The Patio.

Located on the 1st floor.





THE COZY ROOM

This deep, dark, alluring and intimate space featuring original wood flooring from the historic house. The Cozy Room is a deep green black jewel of a room featuring a beautiful antique woven tapestry, original paintings and brass accents. Seats up to 16. Located on the 2ND floor.



THE GARDEN ROOM

The most sunlit room on the entire property, The Garden Room is a vibrant space featuring a collection of lush live plants, garden and floral inspired artwork and artifacts.

Seats up to 24. Located on the 2nd floor.

THE OFFICE

Originally built to be a personal workspace for owner, Tony Foreman, and transformed into an intimate wine room fit with an eclectic mix of wine souvenirs, antique artifacts, as well as modern art. The featured dining tables are parquet-topped French drawing tables from the 1840s. Seats up to 12.

Located on the 2nd floor.
